2016 Brush and Limb Pick-Up guidelines

Pick – Ups will be held the first full week of each month
April – October

Guidelines:

- Limbs must be placed out for pick-up by **7:30 a.m. Monday** on the week of service each month. There will be only one pass-through by the city for each area. If you are missed, or forget to place limbs out for pick-up, you may dispose of them at the city brush site located at 400 E. Quincy St. **Note:** Typical route starts on the west side of the city continuing onto the east side, finishing up on the north side of the underpass. Dates are subject to change based on need or weather conditions.
 - Brush and limbs are to be placed by the alley in the rear of the property, if no alley, brush and limbs are to be placed inside the curb on the park-strip in front of the property.
 - Accepted items include brush, limbs and branches up to 4 inches in diameter, not to exceed 6 feet in length, with soil removed from the roots.
 - The city reserves the right to refuse pick-up at properties not complying with these guidelines. Anything other than the items listed above will not be accepted.
 - Residents are reminded not to block the street or parking with brush and or limbs.
- ❖ *Items taken to the city barns at 400 E. Quincy St. are for **Garrett Utility Residents Only.***

Contractors are not to use our drop off site for their items.
